



Old Guard Fishing Trip

The fishing trip will be on **Friday June 16th from 8:00 am until 2:00 pm**. If you have never been on a fishing trip, now is your chance. Fishing is a fun way to spend time getting to know your fellow members of the Old Guard. The boat is the Snow Goose which sails out of Port Chester. This is not a "shoulder-to-shoulder-let's get-our-lines-tangled" trip. The minimum number of people allowed on the boat is 15 and the maximum is 20. Mates will be available to help you with rods and reels, untangling lines, teaching you how to put bait on the hook, helping you take the fish off the hook, determining if the fish is a "keeper" and cleaning the fish for you.

This year the Captain has decided to no longer charter the whole boat for one group. This means that we will be sharing the boat with other people and it also means space is limited. The Captain indicated he would like to limit our group to 10-12 people. The cost is \$65 per person payable in cash to the Captain once you get on the boat. I will not be collecting any money. The cost includes: Boat, rod & reel, bait and free parking. Cost does not include any drinks or food. Food and Drink are not available for sale on the boat. You may also join the \$5 pool for the largest fish caught. It is customary to tip the staff at the end of the trip. The amount is up to you.

What should you bring:

- Yourself
- Cooler with ice (for your drinks, lunch and snacks and hopefully for any fish you may catch)
- Sunscreen
- Hat
- Rain gear (if the weather calls for it)
- Rag to wipe your hands, clothes, etc
- Waterproof bag (ziplock is fine) for your phone or anything else you want to keep dry.

Notes:

- Fishing license is not required.
- Beer and tobacco products are permitted for anyone aged 21 and over.

-Check the weather and dress appropriately. A rain date depends on the boat availability.

-Do not bring anything or wear anything that you don't want to get wet or have fish guts spilled on.

-Footwear is a personal preference. Some people wear sneakers. Some people wear sandals. Some people wear big rubber boots.

Free Parking is available in front of the Bartaco Restaurant 1-11 Willet Avenue Port Chester NY. Wait in your car and someone will come from the boat to give you a sign to place on the dashboard of your car.

The day of the trip you must be on time! The boat will leave without you.
